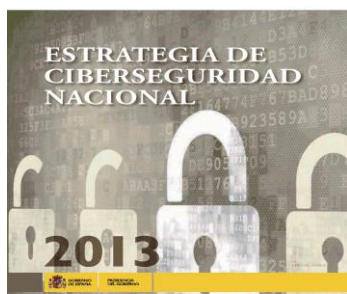
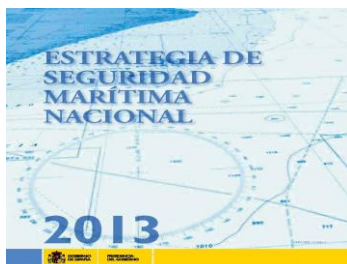

The Association of Spanish Graduates in Security and Defense (ADESyD) will hold the “1st ADESyD Congress” on November 27, under the title “Sharing Views on Security”.

ADESyD promotes the culture of security and defense from a comprehensive approach and in permanent dialogue with society. With this Congress, it reinforces its commitment to help our country play an active role in the creation of security and stability spaces, while encouraging social participation in these issues.

We are aware that we are currently facing increasingly complex and interrelated challenges, entwined within processes that transform traditional security frameworks. The standard division between security and defense no longer exists. The European integration project is yet to be completed; NATO is currently engaged in a strategic re-definition process, and the primary international organization –the UN– is undertaking a structural reform not yet agreed upon. Spain must participate in all these processes as an active member in the main defense and security institutions worldwide.

ADESyD invites its members (Honorary Council and Associates) and those who identify with its purposes, to contribute with their ideas to the areas of study addressed by this “1st Congress”. The awareness about particular and common challenges and the active participation in all integration processes to better tackle them will be the guidelines of this Congress. It also pursues a thorough exchange of views among people with different academic approaches, from different generations and professional backgrounds.
